The Situation You Face

Title V Facilities are required to submit emissions estimates annually to their regulatory authority. In Alabama, these estimates have traditionally been submitted via paper hard copies to the Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM). However, beginning with calendar year 2015's emissions estimates, the ADEM's Air Emissions Electronic Reporting System (AEERS) became available for the submittal of emissions estimates giving facilities the option of submitting their emissions estimates traditionally, or through ADEM's new AEERS. Beginning with emissions estimates for calendar year 2016, the use of ADEM's AEERS will be mandatory.

The AEERS is designed for data to be input manually, or through the use of an XML file, by designated preparers (does not have to be a facility employee). Once the required data has been input into the AEERS, a responsible official can electronically sign and certify report submissions.
